

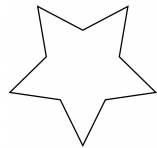

Materials list:

Cake In A Mug - Mix $\frac{1}{4}$ cup flour, 3 T sugar, $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon baking powder, a pinch of salt, Stir in $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon vanilla, 3 T milk and 2 T oil. Optional ingredients include sprinkles, chocolate chips, cut up fruit, etc. Mix well. Put in the microwave for 90 seconds and enjoy!

Playdough Cupcake Tin Project - 1 cup flour, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup salt, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup water (gradually stir it in). After mixing, knead with hands. You can add different color food coloring (5-10 drops) and continue kneading. Gather cupcake tins, liners, candles, sprinkles, gems, etc. for imaginary play!
